This state-of-the-art digital structure spans two sides (southern and eastern) of the Tahlia Mall façade, functioning as a unified display. Installed at eye level, the screen is perfectly visible to motorists driving westward, providing a direct line of sight just before the Al Nawah Roundabout. It is also anamorphic design (3D) capable.

Given the naturally slowing traffic at this junction, especially during peak hours, advertisers benefit from extended exposure as vehicles come to a halt.

Designed for seamless travel, it features dedicated arrival and departure areas, spacious corridors, and multiple entry and exit points to manage high passenger volumes.

Equipped with modern amenities such as prayer halls, restaurants, and duty-free shops, the terminal ensures a comfortable journey. Operating year-round, it serves nearly 7-10 million travelers annually and connects to global flight networks, making it a critical gateway for religious tourism in Saudi Arabia.
